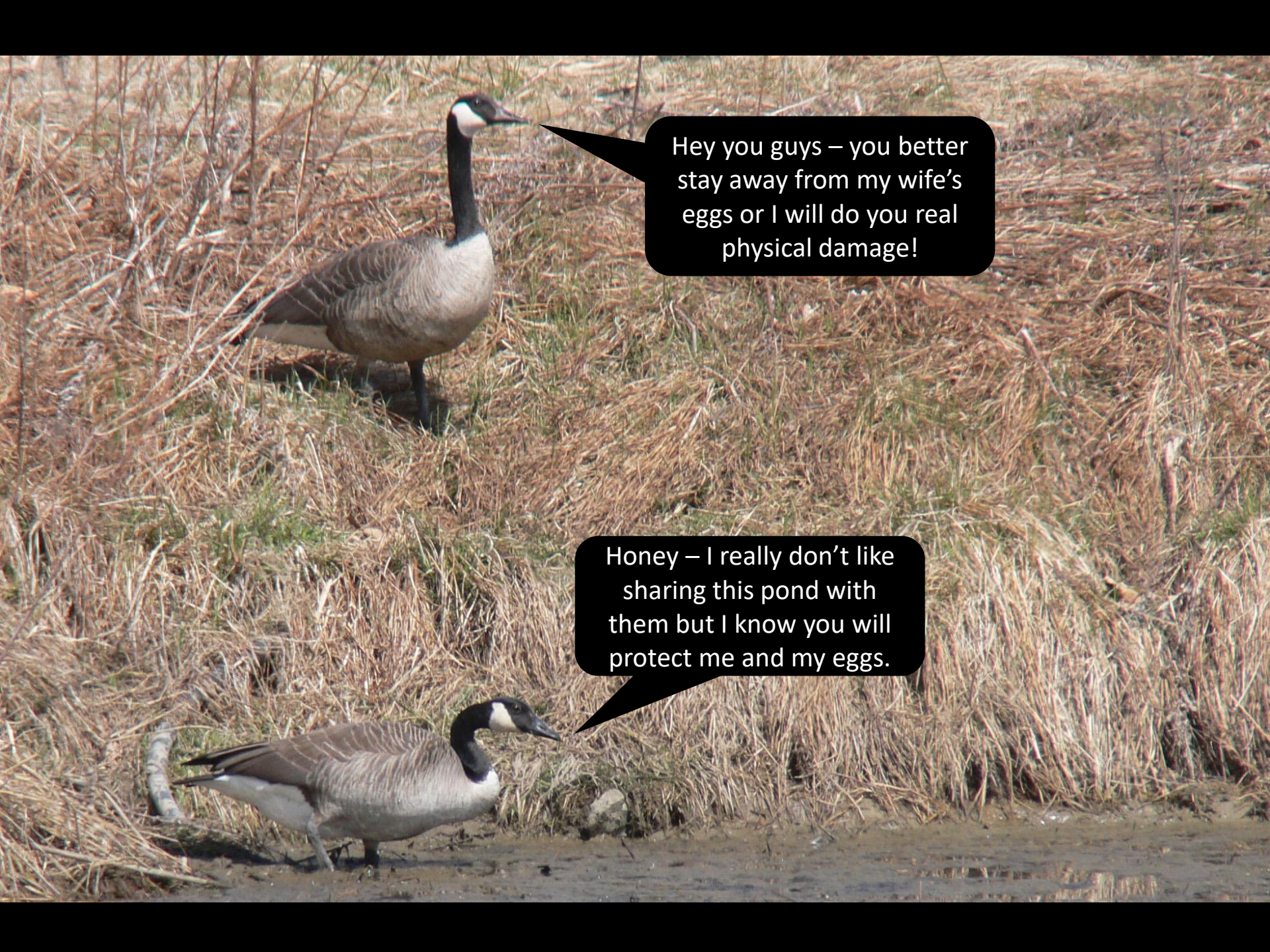


TALL TALES FROM THE POND


